As a Clinical Trial Leader, you will be accountable for all aspects of managing and executing early-phase clinical trials to deliver high-quality data for strategic decision-making and drug registration. You will oversee the planning, implementation, and operational aspects of Phase 1 and clinical pharmacology trials from conception to reporting, ensuring adherence to timelines, budget, and quality standards (ICH/GCP/SOPs and procedures).

This is a hybrid role requiring on-site presence at the Westworks London office three days a week. Please note that we are unable to offer work-permit support for this role.

About the Role

Major Accountabilities:

- Oversight of Outsourced Activities: Focus on Phase I and clinical pharmacology trials, ensuring Clinical Research Organisation (CRO) partners meet timelines and deliverables aligned with project priorities and strategy.
- Team Leadership: Lead and matrix-manage multidisciplinary teams to ensure all trial deliverables are met. Set ambitious goals, promote realistic planning and timelines, and present actionable alternatives to accelerate timelines. Collaborate with line functions to gain input and alignment, managing internal and external stakeholder expectations.
- Study Planning and Set-Up: Lead all aspects of study planning and manage study set-up in collaboration with procurement personnel, team members, and local country office representatives. Interact with CRO partners/sites to ensure smooth study set-up and conduct, review site performance, protocol and quality deviations, and address any issues raised.
- Scientific Review: Prepare, lead, or support the ongoing medical/scientific review of clinical trial data including dose escalation meetings with investigators. Coordinate the real-time availability of quality clinical trial data to provide consolidated information for dose escalation meetings and data review with relevant stakeholders.
