TL also maintains visibility and tracking of current and upcoming projects. The candidate in this role will be expected to work with colleagues located in Hyderabad, Mexico, Ireland and the US. The TL is a part of 'Content' team under CAST and must demonstrate strong collaboration with colleagues across all Novartis sites (India, US, Ireland and Mexico), operate in a metricized environment, maintain highest quality standards, and live Novartis values and behaviors every day.

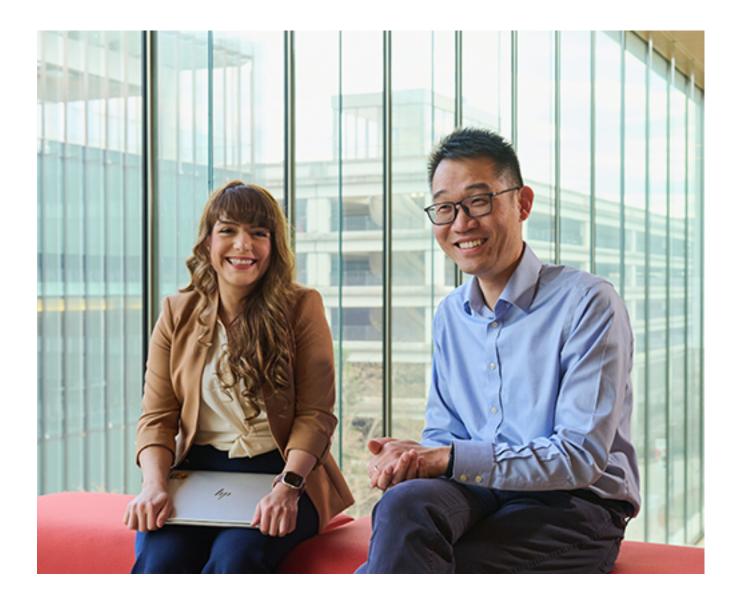
