- Proactively communicate overall project strategy, assess and consolidate resource needs (internal and external costs) and set priorities for the analytical sub-team.
- Support the growth of the sub-team members and motivate them as appropriate through encouragement and servant leadership.
- Lead and manage all analytics related activities of drug product and drug substance development including release and stability-testing, characterization of the API, methoddevelopment, transfer and validation, specification setting, know-how transfer etc.
- Critically evaluate results and draw relevant conclusions.

- PhD and minimum of 8 years' relevant experience in Biologics CMC development or University life-science degree with appropriate industry experience.
- Previous experience in analytical areas in biologic drug development in an industrial setting.
- Excellent understanding of regulatory expectations and requirements with significant experience with IND/ BLA submission.
- Fluency in English.
- Proven leader with minimum of 5 years' experience in managing teams / projects.
- Proven track record of creativity, problem solving and productivity.
- Proficient scientific/technical writing skills.
