- Prepare and conduct hands-on QC Micro technical training and aseptic gowning training
- Support investigations and CAPAs related to aseptic processes within required timelines
- Maintain the training program in accordance with business needs, regulatory requirements, and Quality Management System
- Continuously evaluate and provide improvements on the aseptic training program. Assist in the development and / or review developed training materials for technical accuracy, regulatory compliance, and effectiveness
- Monitor and communicate real-time training gaps to leads and training team, and provide on-going feedback

- 2+ years of related pharmaceutical technical training experience preferably in a production, QA, and/ or QC related role preferred.
- Direct experience working in a GMP and aseptic or sterile environment is required.
- Aseptic gowning and clean room experience is highly desired.
- Cell & gene therapy experience highly desired.
